



Veiled, Speed Structure, a new collection of work by Coco Esteve, opened this week at the sala d'exposicions (exhibition gallery) of the Old Town Hall in Sant Francesc. For three years, the Alcoi-born artist has had a number of lengthy stints on Formentera, periods during which she produced a set of work tackling the speed of the island's characteristic landscape and the swiftly-moving change that marks it. As Esteve explained, "they are abstract paintings that couldn't have been framed in rectangular structures, or even in time". The exhibition can be visited through 29 August, 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 6:30 to 8:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday at the exhibition hall of the Old Town Hall (l'Ajuntament Vell).
